Memex and its evolution (1976–1980) [edit] PARC researchers Maxwell, Peter Ahlberg, Ted Codd, and Robert Kerns began working on Memex in the spring of 1975. They were convinced that the idea of a computer-aided drafting (CAD) program would work, given sufficient computing power and an appropriate interface. The first Memex prototype ran on a PDP-11/20 minicomputer. By 1976, Memex was being developed on a system based on an IBM 7094 mainframe computer running the COBOL programming language. The
